Awards and Scholarships - Commencement 2024

In the fall of their junior year, students take the <u>PSAT/National Merit Scholarship</u> <u>Qualifying Test</u>. Over 1.3 million students took the 2022 Test. From the 50,000 highest scorers nationwide, about 34,000 students were commended for their performance on the PSAT/NMSQT. In early September two Skaneateles high scorers were notified that they had qualified as Semifinalists. To be considered for a National Merit Scholarship, Semifinalists must advance to Finalist standing in the competition by meeting high academic standards. In February 15,000 Semifinalists were notified that they had advanced from Semifinalist to Finalist standing. We are delighted to announce that **Keady Azzam and Colton Sears** are among this group of distinguished High School Senior finalists.

National Merit Scholarship winners are the Finalists in each state judged to have the strongest combination of accomplishments, skills, and potential for success in rigorous college studies. The number of winners named in each state is proportional to the state's percentage of the nation's graduating high school seniors.
